The national conference will be held on 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> October 2019 at the Vodafone Events Centre in Manukau.

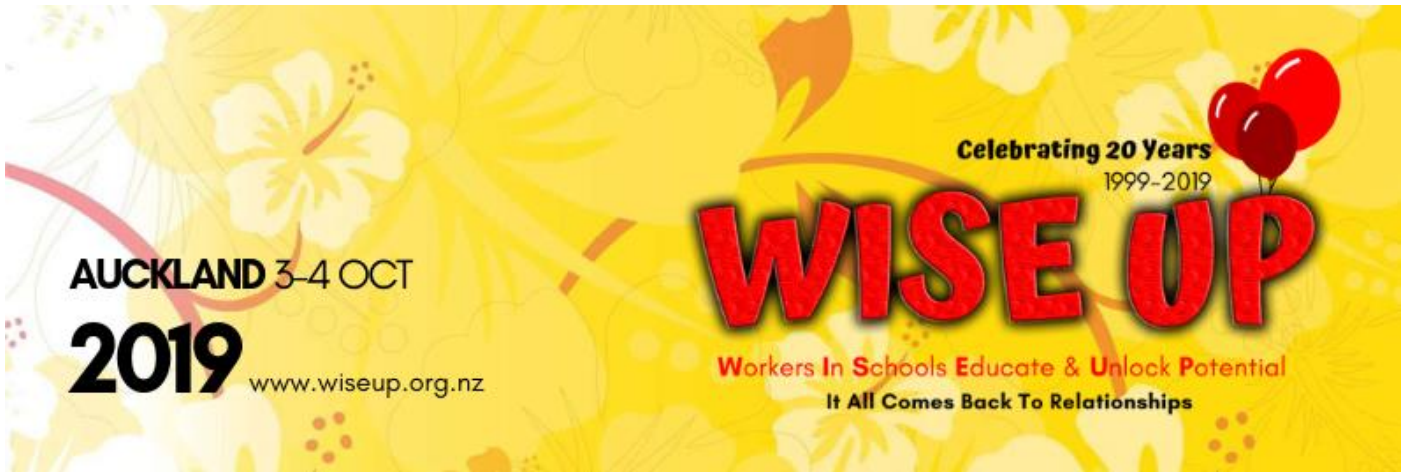
